Spiritual legacy

In February, Cambodia observes Meak Bochea Day, one of the country's most important religious festivals

Buddhist monks clasp lotus flowers at Kol Tor Teng pagoda in Phnom Penh on Meak Bochea Day. *Meak* refers to the name of the third lunar month while *bochea* means “to venerate”. Coinciding with the full moon on the third month of the Khmer calendar (February 8 this year), this hallowed ceremony commemorates the Buddha’s last sermon, during which he is said to have summarised his core teachings to an assembly of disciples and predicted his own death. On this day, devout Buddhists avoid alcohol consumption, prepare food for monks and seek atonement at the city’s temples, including Oudong, a sacred mountain an hour’s drive from Phnom Penh.

Shortcuts

The latest travel inspiration from the region this month

Stairway to heaven

Shenzhen is perhaps better known for its towering steel-and-glass monoliths but if you're looking for a change of scene, the Tower of Spiral is a 15m-high viewing platform surrounded by verdant sunflower fields. The circular structure features a translucent mesh build that allows you to enjoy the view from all angles as you wend your way up. In the evenings, LED lights illuminate the exterior of the tower, giving it the appearance of a Chinese lantern.



A fine balance

Soon, it'll be even easier to make your way around the sprawling Angkor Wat complex with a new cycling path being constructed to ease traffic congestion. The 23km path will take cyclists from the main temple of



Angkor Wat to Ta Keo. But Siem Reap isn't the only destination on the network you will be able to explore by bike. As part of Penang's ongoing Bicycle Route Master Plan, nearly 200km of paths will be available to cyclists in phases by this year. One you can enjoy now is the 12.5km coastal path between George Town and Queensbay Mall in the south. In Xiamen, the Bicycle Skyway, completed in 2017, spans five residential areas and three business districts.

History revisited

Sumptuously restored properties open doors to the region's bygone eras



The Barracks, Singapore

Opened on Sentosa island in December 2019, this former barracks for British soldiers has been refurbished into an elegant 40-room luxury hotel. Plenty of heritage features have been left intact – from traditional timber louvered windows to the heavy molded timber

doors – complementing contemporary fixtures such as leather chesterfield sofas and camping chairs. All rooms face two long, palm-fringed swimming pools. Guests are also treated to a personal equestrian service, with butlers providing round-the-clock assistance. slh.com



Rosewood, Yangon

After a five-year restoration effort, the former New Law Courts, built in the 1920s, has been transformed into an opulent hotel. Most of its original features have been retained, from the scales of justice motif visible throughout the property to its shiny bronze doors, teak handrails and the landscaped internal courtyards. In the rooms and suites, local artwork and artefacts adorn the walls and shelves, juxtaposed with modern, brightly hued textiles. rosewoodhotels.com/en/yangon



Raffles Grand Hotel d'Angkor, Siem Reap

The Grand Hotel d'Angkor first opened in 1932, with the property being taken over by the Raffles brand in 1997. The new iteration featured an increased room count of 119, a vast new pool and landscaped gardens. And now, the grand dame has undergone yet another face-lift,

reopening its doors after a six-month renovation. Rooms have been spruced up with modcons such as spotlights to add extra warmth and brightness, new built-in wardrobes to replace cabinets and new bathrooms fitted with Italian tiling and rain showers. raffles.com/siem-reap

Second to none

There are many reasons to explore the smaller cousins of big-ticket destinations

Second-city travel is set to be a major trend this year. A 2019 survey by Booking.com found that 51% of global travellers would swap their original destination for a similar alternative to reduce their environmental impact.

“Second-city travel relieves the effects of overtourism, such as pollution and stresses on public infrastructure, in popular destinations,” explains Angel Llull, the company’s APAC VP. “It also enables smaller communities to gain from tourism.”

Travellers benefit, too. “You’ll get to contend with fewer crowds and enjoy cheaper prices,” Llull says, “and gain new experiences from going off the beaten track.”

Luckily, this part of the world is packed with exciting second cities, from Cambodia to India. Here are some top picks.

Blitar

Three hours from Surabaya, this small city in East Java is surrounded by numerous ancient temples.

Where to play

Penataran Temple is the largest Hindu temple in East Java. Located on the slope of an active volcano, Mt Kelud, it was built in the late 12th century, during the Kediri Kingdom. The restoration work is impeccable – showing off detailed stone carvings of scenes from the Sanskrit epic poem, *Ramayana*.

Where to stay

A restored colonial mansion with tasteful antique furnishings and old photographs, Hotel Tugu has spacious suites that carefully blend Javanese design with contemporary fittings. Its largest, Sang Fajar, comes with a hand-carved Javanese bed.

How to get there

You can drive from Surabaya or take the longer but more picturesque five-hour train ride through lush forests and rural Javanese villages.



Secunderabad

Founded in 1806 as a cantonment for the British forces, Hyderabad's twin city offers bustling bazaars and fascinating historic buildings.

Where to play

Hussain Sagar Lake is a heart-shaped lake built in 1563. In the middle of the lake is a 16m-high Buddha statue, which can be reached by boat.

Where to stay

Minerva Grand Secunderabad is a centrally located boutique stay with spacious rooms that offer picturesque city views.

How to get there

Secunderabad is 20 minutes by train from Hyderabad.

Lenggong

Lenggong Valley is Malaysia's fourth Unesco World Heritage site, and the town is where archaeologists found the 11,000-year-old Perak Man, the oldest and most complete skeleton unearthed in Southeast Asia.



Where to play

Malaysia's Mini Amazon fishing camp at Kampung Beng offers boat explorations and angling trips on the Perak River and Chenderoh Lake.

Where to stay

Rumah Tiang 16 is a traditional Malay kampung house transformed into a boutique homestay. It offers an immersive programme that includes preparing local dishes and visiting a village of kite-makers.

How to get there

From Penang, it's a two-hour drive to Lenggong.



Kampot

Despite its go-slow vibe, this sleepy riverside town in Cambodia has plenty to offer, from architecture to nature.

Where to play

Kampot is famed for its namesake pepper, so consider a visit to La Plantation, an organic farm that conducts free guided walks. Or simply wander the streets to admire the faded grandeur of its

colonial-era buildings, perhaps picking up a *num pang* (pork baguette) from a roadside stall.

Where to stay

GreenHouse, on the banks of Kampot River, offers rustic bungalows replete with swinging hammocks.

How to get there

A mini-bus ride from Phnom Penh takes about three hours.

No extra baggage

Romantic getaways are not just for the coupled-up, as this writer discovers

I am all alone in the middle of paradise – in a spacious bungalow with a king-size bed and a jacuzzi, on a tiny island in the middle of the Maldives. I checked in to Maafushivaru the day before and as a treat, the resort has organised a night at their honeymoon outpost on a secluded island a short boat ride away.

After preparing a lavish feast on the beach for me, the kitchen crew has returned to the main island. As I tuck into my meal, I suddenly notice hundreds of crabs emerging from the shallows and scuttling around my table and feet. Over the past four years as a digital nomad, I've gotten well-acquainted with the weird and wonderful experiences of solo travel but this is a whole other level. Scenes from the TV series *Lost* crowd my mind as I ponder my solitude.

Thankfully, as night falls, the rain comes and chases the crabs away, and I breathe a sigh of relief. I use the lack of audience to cartwheel on the beach and greet the rain. The rest of my trip passes in a state of bliss as I explore the crystal-clear waters and enjoy my self-chosen solitude at each resort I visit.

Solo female travel has been on the rise in recent years but travelling alone to romantic destinations like the Maldives or Bali requires that much more mettle. I'm often asked how I travel to all these exotic destinations surrounded by lovebirds and not feel lonely. My answer? Being alone allows me to fully immerse myself in the moment. Instead of thinking of conversation topics or worrying about my partner's enjoyment, I have the freedom to do whatever I want and go wherever I fancy.

Having gone on several other "solomoons" since my last eventful trip to the Maldives, I can safely say I love this kind of travel and would recommend it to anyone. More than the physical expedition, the journey your soul traverses makes each experience extra meaningful.

Market trends

Chow Kit, Kuala Lumpur's old merchant district, is experiencing a new verve

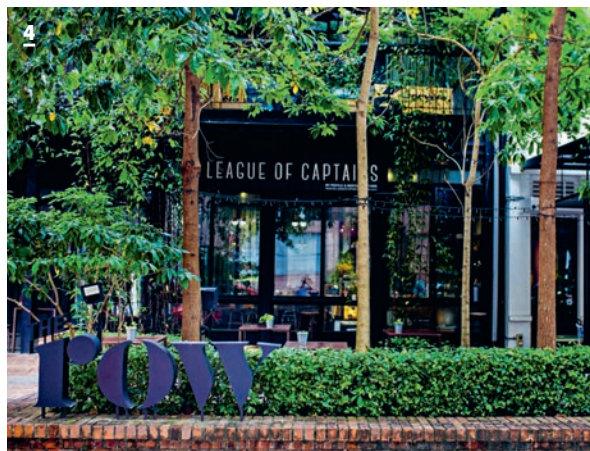
A short stroll west of KL's Petronas Towers lies Chow Kit, a neighbourhood with a chequered past. The northern end still buzzes with wholesalers, hawker stalls and Pasar Chow Kit, a wet market thought to be Malaysia's oldest. But venture south, away from the hustle, and you'll find quieter streets where new businesses are putting down roots.

1. Rise and Shine by Tapestry

Opening its doors on Jalan Kamunting in the second half of 2019, this restaurant has proved an instant hit with Kuala Lumpur's brunch-loving crowd with its high ceilings, exposed brick and natural light. Popular items include the *shakshouka* (eggs baked in tomato-based sauce with lamb meatballs) and the assorted smoothie bowls. Proudly local, they source ingredients for much of the menu from the nearby wet market. tapestrydining.my

2. MoMo's

This new kid on the block touts itself as a "social hotel", with a lobby that doubles as an event space for pop-up food vendors, artisans and DJs. There is also a taco bar serving tequila until the small hours. The boutique stay features minimalist-style rooms with quirky LED lighting. Located in the heart of Chow Kit, MoMo's is the ideal base for exploring both sides of this vibrant neighbourhood. stayatmomos.com



3. Loke Mansion

Chow Kit is home to dozens of heritage buildings, from pretty 1920s shophouses to the imposing Loke Mansion, built in 1892 by a local business tycoon. Tucked behind rain trees, the building was restored in 2006 by a local law firm that now uses its premises as its offices. Tourists are welcome to look around the mansion and admire its medley of architectural styles – from a Chinese moongate to Dutch gable ends.

4. The Row

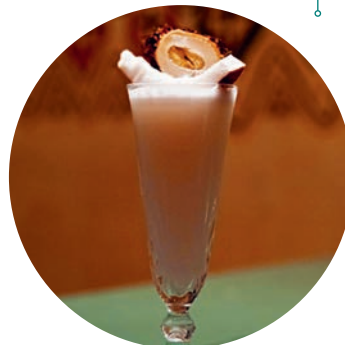
On a mission to exemplify adaptive reuse and responsible urban regeneration in Chow Kit, The Row is a block of 1940s shophouses, beautifully restored in 2015 and repopulated with an eclectic mix of boutiques, cafés and other lifestyle businesses. Pick up artisanal gifts such as local Malaysian batik from Peter Hoe, grab a cuppa at the cosy Common Grind or peruse the community-run Sunny Side Up Market for handmade jewellery and cosmetics. fb.com/therowkl

5. Joloko

Residing opposite Rise and Shine, in a canary-yellow townhouse, this award-winning Afro-Caribbean cocktail bar has been shaking up Chow Kit's nightlife scene since July 2018. Often bustling with the city's trendy set, the lively bar is known for serving nearly 50 varieties of mezcal including Almamezcalera, rarely found outside Mexico but widely considered one of the world's best. bar-joloko.com

with history

Davao-based fashion designers are collaborating with indigenous cultures to help keep their heritage alive

In the last year, a humble accessory has been gracing the glossy pages of Philippine fashion magazines and the social media accounts of popular influencers. Known as the *tangkulo*, this triangular piece of cloth adorned with beadwork and pompoms is worn around the neck to elevate a simple outfit or accent dressier pieces. Traditionally a headscarf from the Bagobo Tagabawa tribe of the Davao region, it is one of the many examples of how Mindanaoan indigenous culture has begun permeating the mainstream fashion scene.

It's no surprise that Davao's fashion designers are drawing inspiration from their environment. Beyond its lush mountains and pristine beaches, Mindanao has unparalleled cultural richness and religious diversity. Comprised of 27 provinces and over 26 ethno-linguistic tribes, the Philippines' second-largest island is a melting pot of cultures. The Davao region alone has 11 indigenous tribes, each with their own unique artisanal traditions. From the Manobo tribes known for intricate beadwork to the cross-stitch embroidery of the T'boli, there is much to inspire the modern-day designer.

Working with tradition is by no means easy. Designers must be mindful of cultural appropriation and nurture sustainable relationships with their indigenous partners. This means ensuring that their fabrics and archetypal designs are used with respect as well as paying artisans a fair price for their work.

"Consultation is key," explains Lenora Cabili, a Mindanao native and founder of local brand Filip+Inna. "It is important to give the artisans proper value for their work, and give back to the community through different programmes."

Read on to find out more about Cabili's work as well as three other proudly Mindanaoan designers from Davao and the neighbouring cities of Iligan and Zamboanga.

The Pioneer

Lenora Cabili of Filip+Inna

With her label established in 2010, Cabili – who hails from Illigan City – was one of the first to bring traditional elements to the mainstream market with ready-to-wear pieces such as hand-embroidered shorts and pencil skirts. In February 2019, Cabili was among Philippine magazine *People Asia*'s People of the Year 2019, in recognition of the work she has done to integrate local artisans into mainstream fashion.

Who are the communities you work with?

We work with about 26 groups around the Philippines – each group bringing in a particular tradition from their culture. In Mindanao, we collaborate with the T'boli tribe particularly for their intricate cross-stitch embroidery that graces our shorts, shirts and skirts. The Blaan are very skilled embroiderers as well but do wonderful beadwork for us, using mother-of-pearl beads. We also use the beautiful geometric weaves from the Islamic Maranao people of Lake Lanao and the richly coloured handwoven abaca textiles of the

Manobo tribes, which accent our bolero jackets and scarves.

How has your background inspired your work?

I grew up in Mindanao and was exposed to the Maranaos of Marawi City on the shores of Lake Lanao. My summers were spent in Basilan, an island off the Zamboanga Peninsula. Then my years of dancing with the Bayanihan Philippine Folk Dance Company expanded my knowledge of Philippine indigenous groups. Filip+Inna is the intertwining of my love for fashion and Philippine culture.

How do you give back to the communities?

At the end of the year, we share our profits with the artisans who contributed the most to the collections. We also give back through scholarships and livelihood programmes. Our latest is the Bahay Kubo Program, which will introduce sustainable farming to the artisans so they can fully utilise their land. Our pilot project is with the T'boli tribe since they comprise the largest number of artisans that we work with. »

The Innovator

Topping Zamora

Despite not having a formal fashion background, Topping Zamora decided to give up managing the family insurance business and pursue his passion. In 2014, he opened a bridal boutique, and in 2016 enrolled in the Philippine Women’s College of Davao to study fashion before launching his eponymous brand in 2018. Zamora immediately started turning heads with his pretty pastel separates and dresses, embellished with beadwork inspired by indigenous motifs and utilising a custom-woven plaid cotton textile called *gintlo* from the Blaan tribe.

Recently awarded the Grand Winner title at the Stellar Mindanao Heritage Fashion Designers Competition in 2019, Zamora has also been showcased abroad at the Borneo International Beads Conference and the Budayaw Fashion Show, both in Kuching, Malaysia.

What sparked your interest in working with indigenous communities?

In 2018, in my last year as a fashion student, I wrote a research paper on the Bagobo Tagabawa’s headscarf, commonly known as *tangkulo*. I studied the patterns and techniques and their significance to the Bagobo people. I fell in love with the artisans’ passion and attention to detail. From then on, I vowed to promote local weaves and native craftsmanship in my work.

Who are the communities you work with?

The Bagobo Tagabawa community in Lubogan, Toril, and the Blaan women of Kiblawan. Apart from using the Bagobo Tagabawa’s *tangkulo* headscarf in most of our collections, we also work with the community to adorn apparel with their traditional beadwork called *pangulabe*.

What are your signature looks?

I use a custom woven *gintlo* in vibrant colours depending on the season. In 2019, I was inspired by the annual Kadayawan Festival in Davao, a thanksgiving event where people often parade in colourful costumes. »



Where to stay

Just a 20-minute boat ride from Davao Airport, on the lush island of Samal, is the luxurious Pearl Farm Beach Resort. The villas and over-water cottages are designed by famed architect Bobby Mañosa, inspired by the nipa roof

stilts houses of the Sulu, with high ceilings and wide openings to allow for air circulation. The spaces are decorated with local textiles, reinterpreted as wall coverings, throw pillows and accessories. pearlfarmresort.com

**Bea Constantino of
Herman & Co.**

Bomber jackets, batik crop-tops and wide-legged trousers are some of the signature looks of this fun and youthful brand established in 2016. Designed for the modern woman, the pieces are easily incorporated into everyday looks. Hailing from Zamboanga City and Sulu, founder Bea Constantino is sensitive to the difficulties of conflict areas and how cut off they can be from the economy. She designs with socio-economic rehabilitation in mind, choosing her textile sources from areas most in need.

What's your brand philosophy?

We are a heritage clothing line that puts a special spotlight on traditional textiles from Mindanao. We aim to bridge the gap between conflict areas, like my province of Sulu, to the mainstream marketplace so as to aid more livelihood and trading opportunities. Aside from traditional weaves, we use commercial textiles from local merchants in the province. They are not locally made but as part of our aim to help the communities sustain business, we buy textiles such as batik and Malay-influenced embroidered fabric from them.

Where do you get inspiration?

The weaves we use have to be appropriate to the community they represent. For example, the Tausug weaves are encouraged to only be used from the waist up. Our designs revolving around that weave are more modest and conservative. Also, each collection begins with a narrative we would like to communicate and is interpreted through the colour palettes and silhouettes of the clothing. For example, we have a collection named Kusug, which means "strong" in our dialect. Inspired by the courageous warrior heritage of the Tausug tribes of Sulu, the collection features very bold and vibrant colours.

What's next for you as a creative director?

I am developing products that encourage wellness and mindful living, such as candles and bath products made from locally sourced essential oils and ingredients like mangosteen and *suwa-itlog*, a type of lime that is only found in Sulu.

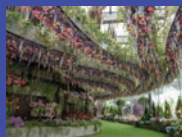

The Rising Star

Marga Nograles of Kaayo

Born, raised and residing in Davao, Marga Nograles initially started making clothes in 2017 as a hobby. Her passion has now grown into a full retail concept, with a recent store opening all the way in Makati City, Manila. Sophisticated separates like silk pajama coordinates, or Kaayo's signature crop-tops adorned with traditional beadwork or a touch of local fabric, make trendy and easy-to-wear wardrobe additions.

How would you describe your brand philosophy?

Kaayo means "inspire kindness" in Cebuano. Each project we

embark on tells a unique story. We recently collaborated with MovEd, which provides early childhood learning to underprivileged areas, for a collection to benefit the war-stricken town of Marawi. MovEd founder Alex Eduque, who is a graphic artist, drew iconic Mindanaoan symbols such as pineapples or durians, which were then beaded or embroidered on the clothing. We raised enough to provide 500 school kits for students in Marawi City.

What traditions do you incorporate in your work?

I use weaves from different

Mindanaoan tribes in my designs such as *t'nalak* and *dagmay* – handwoven cloths of abaca fibres rendered in different patterns – and *yakan*, a cotton and silk weave that showcases boldly coloured geometric patterns.

How has your family's position in Davao inspired your work?

My family has been collaborating with the T'boli tribe for their beadwork and weaves for decades now. We just got back from a trip where we brought their master weaver to the Shanghai Arts and Design College to exchange ideas and showcase the craft. ■

KEYS *to the* KINGDOM

New creative projects
offer even more reasons
to visit Vietnam's former
royal capital of Hue

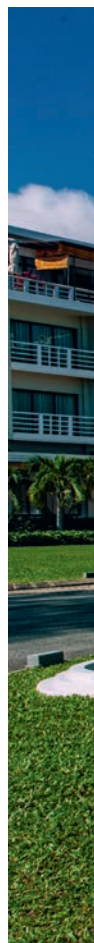
It's early evening
and the gentle
waters of Hue's
tree-fringed
Perfume River
reflect a clear
half-moon.



Resting on the pristine riverbank is Ben Xuan Garden House Theatre, flaunting imperial architecture emblematic of the city's history as Vietnam's last royal capital. Wooden pillars support a tiled roof dotted with mythical creatures shaped by shards of broken porcelain and pottery – examples of artisanal mosaic art that also adorns Hue's royal palace.

Within the central structure, Camille Huyen, Ben Xuan's co-owner and designer, steps onto a makeshift stage enrobed in a crimson *ao dai* (long tunic). She bows with royal grace and a string quartet begins strumming traditional instruments. In a deeply hypnotic voice, Huyen starts singing an interpretation of Hue's native royal chamber music, serenading a gathering of some 20 local officials, intellectuals and artists. The event is the Autumn Concert for the Perfume River, the last in a trio of concerts arranged in 2019 by Huyen and her husband, Truong Dinh Ngo.

According to the local Department of Tourism, most visitors still only spend one or





two days in Hue, 100km north of Danang, opting to focus almost exclusively on the Imperial City and the royal tombs. This is a shame, laments Ho Chi Minh City-based British historian Tim Doling and author of *Exploring Hue: Heritage of the Nguyen Dynasty Heartland*, a 2018 guide that encourages visitors and locals to explore beyond the major sites. “Hue is special because of the sheer breadth of physical heritage which remains – the relics, temples, houses, tombs – much of which hasn’t been touched by tourism,” Doling says.

“Foreign tourists’ awareness of Hue is still minimal, and this isn’t helped by local agents that overlook the city’s quiet charms,” adds Hue resident Phan Trong Minh, general manager of the Azerai La Residence, the city’s premium heritage hotel. After having worked in tourism for over a decade, Phan is keen for the city to realise its potential. “With new cultural and tourism projects, such as Ben Xuan Garden House Theatre, I believe that people will start seeing Hue in a new light,” he says.

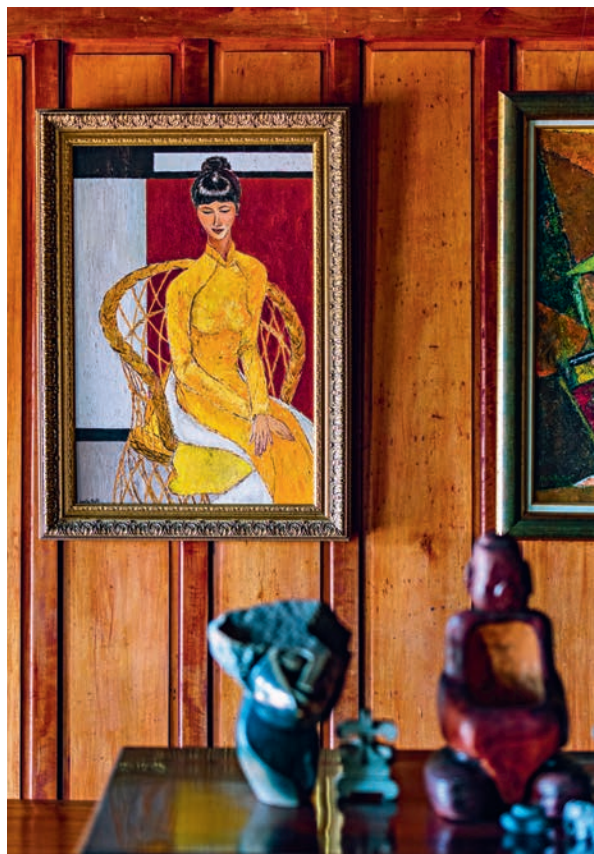
Ben Xuan sits on the western edge of Hue, an area known for century-old garden houses like An Hien and Xuan Vien Tieu Cung. With a lush garden and idyllic ponds, Ben Xuan shares many of the same features as the neighbourhood’s ancient buildings, though with notable royal flourishes such as the mosaic-adorned rooftops. And yet it was only completed in March 2017.

Huyen, a descendent of Minh Mang, the second Nguyen dynasty emperor, was born in Hue and at 19 moved to Paris to study at university. In France, she met Truong Dinh, a banker working in Switzerland but born in the neighbouring province of Quang Tri, and decided to devote her life to the arts after marriage. Together, they spent years and not an insignificant amount of money salvaging abandoned materials from historic buildings in Hue that were destroyed during the war or lost to redevelopment.

After a decade of collecting century-old bricks from ruins, broken porcelain from shipwrecks and old wood pulled from patrician »

houses, the couple began construction on Ben Xuan, based on Huyen's designs and inspired by her royal heritage. Beginning in 2008, the garden house took nine years to complete. And after 40 years spent in Europe, the couple retired, moved back to Hue and opened their new home to welcome high-end travellers.

Visitors can get in touch through the website to arrange private performances while invitation-only concerts – such as Autumn Concert for the Perfume River – showcase the value of Hue's heritage to the city's decision-makers. "We invite people from the cultural and tourism departments to show them another way besides mass tourism," Truong Dinh explains, referencing the explosive tourism growth in nearby Danang and Hoi An. "Hue's heritage is special and that is what we should promote."

Beyond Ben Xuan's traditional music performances, the couple's international background lends itself to collaborations with musicians and artists from abroad. Vietnam has a long history of absorbing global influences to enrich its evolving culture, from Chinese Confucianism to French fashion. "For us, heritage is the stream of cultures flowing continually from history into our life of today," Truong Dinh says. "Heritage can only survive when integrated into the lives of people."

A royal renaissance

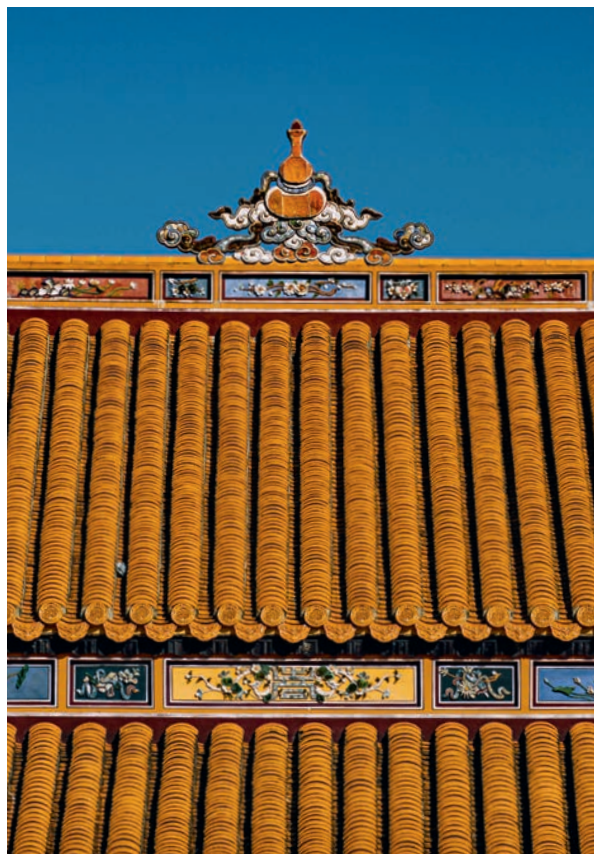
Savouring private performances at Ben Xuan comes at a price, but Hue's rich heritage and cultural offerings aren't only available to travellers with deep pockets. This April sees the 10th edition of the biennial Hue Festival, which began in 2000 and is one of Vietnam's most ambitious international cultural events. With entry tickets costing just a few US dollars, the festival is accessible to visitors and locals alike.

During the festival, the 200-year-old Imperial City, Hue's premier attraction, comes alive with music and performance art. The palace grounds – roughly the size of 35 football pitches – are nestled north of the river and »

were home to the Nguyen kings until 1945, when Bao Dai, Vietnam's last emperor, abdicated the throne. The highlight of the festival takes place in the evenings when the Unesco-recognised chambers, gardens, libraries and former administrative buildings accommodate performances from Hue, but also from other parts of the world. This year's participants include an a capella group from the US, a dance troupe from Russia and a saxophonist quartet from Austria, among others.

But despite its global reach, organisers have not lost sight of the original purpose. "The main aim of the festival is – and has always been – to preserve and promote Hue's cultural heritage," explains Huynh Tien Dat, director of the Hue Festival Centre and a lifetime resident of the city. According to Huynh, the festival attracts foreign dignitaries, preservationists and supporters of the arts, and that helps generate funding for the city.

"Since 2000, there's been greater attention given to Hue's heritage monuments, and donations from international organisations for preservation projects has increased," Huynh says. "It has also enabled opportunities for local artists and artisans to showcase our heritage to an

international audience." This year, performance groups from the Hue Academy of Music and the Hue Traditional Royal Theatre of Art will take to the stage.

Preserving artisanal crafts

While the palace grounds are propelled into the spotlight every two years, a permanent project breathes life into a small corner of the palace grounds throughout the year. The Mosaic of Hue opened in April 2019 on the east watchtower, one of the many buildings that was destroyed during the war and then rebuilt. A cultural space that organises events such as monthly exhibitions and tea ceremonies for visitors to the Imperial City, The Mosaic of Hue is focused on recreating the customs of the past.

"We put in a lot of research to offer authentic Nguyen dynasty tea ceremonies," says CEO Le Thu Hoai. Besides enjoying tea ceremonies, visitors can browse the gift shop, which offers exquisite artisanal products such as lacquer paintings and boxes, hand-painted fans and bold silver and gold jewellery pieces. Le, a Hanoian who fell in love with Hue on her first visit in 2016, carefully sources each product from Hue's most skilled artisans. »

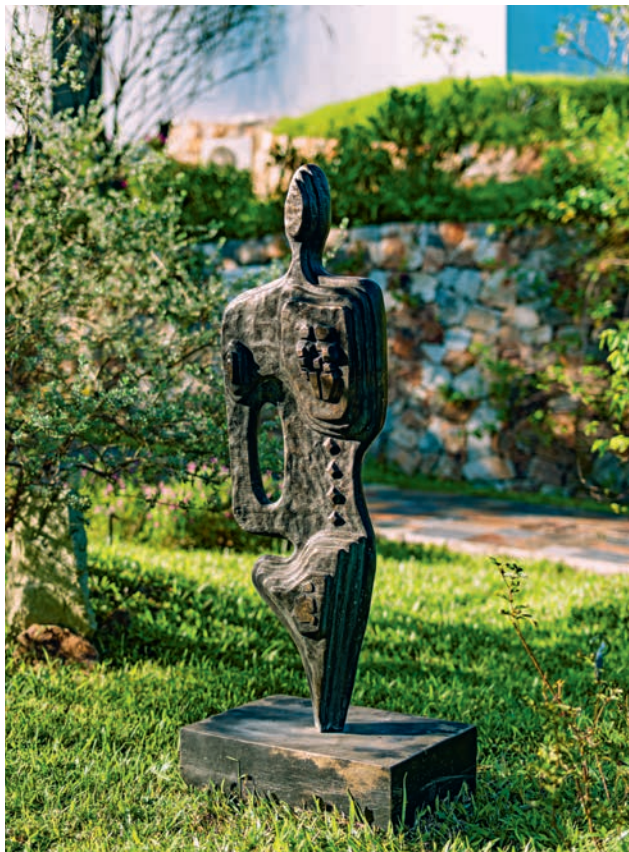

What to eat in Hue

Bun bo Hue

A rich, brothy beef noodle soup with lemongrass and chilli.

Banh Hue

Bite-size savoury cakes made with rice flour, shrimp and pork.

Nha hang chay (vegan cuisine)

With a largely Buddhist population, Hue cooks up many classics in vegan form, alongside dishes like tofu with lemongrass and stewed aubergine.

Where to stay

On the southern banks of the Perfume River stands an example of Hue's colonial heritage: Azerai La Residence. Built in the 1920s, the 122-room hotel features a sweeping curved façade, crisp horizontal lines and circular porthole windows. Managed by Azerai since February 2018, this storied stay also boasts a large garden that extends down to the river. azerai.com

"The artists and artisans used to just work by themselves, but this project has helped them connect to each other and show their skills to the world," Le explains. "Each artist has an important story to tell and having a space like this helps keep that story alive."

A home for the arts

Also keeping stories alive is Lebadang Memory Space, a modern art gallery celebrating the life and works of Le Ba Dang, an acclaimed artist from neighbouring Quang Tri province. The 16km² area, which opened in April 2019, supports 2,700 different trees and plants. Its spacious one-room gallery houses the French-educated artist's most prized works, including paper art, watercolours, oil paintings, sculpture, tapestries and jewellery. Lebadang Memory Space sits south of the city among Hue's royal tombs, enormous outdoor Unesco-recognised resting places built for – and by – the kings of the Nguyen dynasty.

"Look how the trees dance in the wind," exclaims Hue local Le Cam Te, director of Lebadang Memory Space, as she gleefully points out the swaying forest that envelops the expansive garden. Le (no relation to Le Ba Dang),

also an artist, began working with Le Ba Dang after he attended one of her exhibitions in 2002. After his death in 2015, she moved to extend that legacy and honour his wishes for a garden art space in the Hue countryside. She gathered the investment from his family, collectors and other lovers of the artist's work and then invited his wife, Myshu Nguyen-Le, to consult during the design and landscaping process.

"This complex was a dream he used to speak about all the time," Le reminisces. In the garden are pieces of art created by Hue's local artist community in honour of Le Ba Dang. "The moment people walk through the gate, they are entering a giant piece of art," Le says.

For decades, Hue sat eclipsed by the economic miracle of Danang and the charms of Hoi An. Now, as these better-known destinations grapple with their own popularity, Hue is poised to welcome greater numbers of visitors. "Hoi An needs to expand its products to take the pressure off the old town," opines Doling. "The same is true for Hue, but it's easier here because there is just so much more to discover." With this fresh wave of ventures intent on reinstating Hue's status as a culture capital, Doling's sentiment is truer now than ever before. ■
